

### Why Do We Rotate?

We rotate to put our crew in the best position to officiate

 Rotating allows each official to focus on their Primary Coverage Area (PCA)

Rotating properly reduces missed calls


#### When Do I Rotate

- When should we rotate?
- Ray Lutz would say "If you looking over there, the ball is over there, and most of the offense is over there rotate.
- True or false: The Lead official always initiates the rotation?

#### When Do I Rotate

 Answer: False - The lead official usually initiates the rotation but sometimes a closely guarded count by the center official may initiate the rotation.

Competitive match-ups are good indicators to rotate
